# .. Grammar corner ............

- To describe what is happening at the moment we are talking (in other words, now this minute). we use the present continuous.
- To make the present continuous positive we use the verb to be (am, is, are) and the verb root We are watching TV. with the suffix ing.
  I am reading a book. He's playing football.
- To make the negative, we put not between am, is or are and the verb root with the suffix -ling. We use short forms as for the verb to be.

  I'm not sleeping.

  They are not singing.
- To make a question, we put Am, Is, or Are before the personal pronoun (1, you, he, she, it, we, they) and then the verb root with the suffix -ing. Is she playing tennis? Are you cooking?
- In short answers we do not repeat the verb root with the suffix -ing Are they cooking?


